Tryouts are for purposes of player placement and not for specific positions. Coaches select players through a player draft based on lottery selection.

The age of a player on April 30, 2012, will determine in which division he or she will play:

T-Ball 4-6 y/o and under Farm: 7-8 y/o or if 6 then one year of tball with Arapahoe Little League Majors: 9-10 y/o

Little League: 11-12 y/o
Juniors: 14 y/o and under

LEAGUE BOUNDARIES

A player must live with the Arapahoe Little League boundaries and provide proof of residency in order to be eligible to play.

Western Boundary: Quebec St.

Northern Boundary: Denver International Airport/Rocky Mountain Arsenal

Eastern Boundary: Gun Club Road and residences east of there Southern Boundary: Hampden Ave. on both sides of the Reservoir

Letter from the President

Welcome to another year of baseball at Arapahoe Little League.

I would like to thank all the volunteers that make this league the success that it is. Without the board members that work on the day-to-day operations, the coaches that put forth the effort into molding young kids' lives, and the parents that support their children, none of this would be possible. With a continued effort on everyone's part, we can build Arapahoe Little League into the greatest program in the state.

Arapahoe Little League is a valuable resource for the community. It provides children the chance to mold friendships that can last a lifetime. Baseball will teach children valuable lessons of discipline, sportsmanship, good work ethic and camaraderie with fellow players.

There will be many changes this year in accordance to Little League International's (LLI) initiatives to create a competitive balance in all divisions. We will be requiring all players in the majors (9-10), little league (11-12) and juniors (13-14) to attend two separate assessment sessions and go through the player draft. For those of you familiar with the league, there will be no property players assigned to teams they played for last year. In the farm division (7-8) and Tball (4-6), LLI rules do not allow coaches to bring in complete teams. This will help to create exciting, competitive games on a daily basis. This will create an environment where all teams w have the same chance at success.

This year we have entered a partnership with the Colorado Fireworks Tournament. This is a girls' softball tournament for high-school-age participants throughout the world. The tournament will be running the last week of June during the day. The Tournament has donated portable pitching mounds and a generous donation to the League in exchange for using our facilities. These mounds should prove to be a much better surface for our children to pitch from given the unpredictable rain we have seen in the past. There will be ample volunteer opportunities available for parents to fulfill their 10 hour requirement during this event.

Being that this is my first full year as president of Arapahoe Little League, I ensure you that I will put forth every effort to make this league as successful as I can. We have a strong board of directors that feels the same way.
