You will need to provide the following to Arapahoe Little League in order to complete player registration.

- Player Birth Certificate
- Proof of Residency
- Medical Release Form
- Code of Conduct

These documents can be returned to the League at (or before) uniform pickup.

You will also need to verify that you live within the League's boundaries. A <u>Boundary Map</u> is available on our website, or you can contact our Player Agent, Carlos Jimenez, at <u>arapahoellplayeragent@gmail.com</u> to have your address mapped and verified. tournament will be running the first week of July during the daytime hours. # **Registration Information**

Online registration has begun and will end on April 20th. Simply go to our <u>website</u> and click on "Baseball Registration" or "Softball Registration" to sign up.

Please keep in mind that divisions are based on a child's age as of 04/30/13. Birth certificates are required. If you wish for your child to "play up", please contact the Director of Coaching, <u>Thate Wilmes</u>.

A player must also live within the <u>League Boundaries</u> and provide proof of residency in order to compete. Our boundaries are roughly DIA/Rocky Mountain Arsenal, Hampden Avenue, Gun Club Road and Quebec Street.

The fees for 2013 are posted on our website. All pricing includes a \$50 uniform deposit. This deposit will be returned at the end of the season if the player's family completes at least 10 hours of volunteer time. Please contact <u>Chris Wiensch</u> if you would like to apply for a scholarship.

# **Player Tryouts**

All players Farm Level and higher are required to attend one of four assessment sessions. During these tryouts, a player will demonstrate various skills including hitting, throwing and fielding. Each child will be scored, and these ratings will be used in the final player draft.
